## Stylus or Shaft

Entasis is the Taper that runs 2-3rds down the column shaft last third is straight

Note:  
Positioning of columns to an entry. The center bay to the main entry should be slightly wider than the other column in the row.

For the Corners use a 2 sided Volutes and add a single volute on the side

Romans created angled volutes for straight runs and corners  
Scamozzi Style are angled volutes
